

## Minutes of PCC Committee Meeting held on July 8<sup>th</sup> 2020 at Reetox Outback.

The meeting was opened at 1910

There were no minutes of the last meeting.

### 1. Accounts.

Simon opened the meeting with a summary of the accounts. Precise details are not for public consumption, but the PCC has a satisfactory operating surplus thanks to our sponsors and income from kit sales and fees from games played.

### 2. Rugby School Proposal.

Details are still under discussion and thus are confidential at the point, but in broad terms, PCC and RST intend to form a Partnership for their mutual benefit and the furtherance of cricket in the Pattaya area and Thailand as a whole. Action: Simon & Ryan

### 3. Teams for social cricket and the Bangkok Cricket League (BCL).

PCC intends to enter 2 teams into the BCL starting in November. One team will comprise of the best available players from PCC and RST and will play in Division A. The other team, somewhat more socially orientated cricketers, will play in Division B. It is hoped that after a season of settling in, both teams may move up a division to the Premiership and Division A. Simon and Ryan will be the selection committee for the teams. Action Simon & Ryan

### 4. Fixtures for social and league cricket.

The Pattaya Indoor Cricket league will recommence in mid-September at the new sport hall at RST. Ryan will organise the fixtures and Clive will sort out the umpires. Action: Ryan and Clive.

Andy promulgated a call for a social game at St Andrews on 12 July, but reported a very low level of interest. Some members of the Committee stated they had not received the call and it was decided to re-issue the call and cancel/proceed with the game as required. Action: Andy.

Outdoor games for October and November will not be scheduled due to weather.

### 5. Net facility.

In late 2018, Clive researched the costs of mobile cricket nets, but the work was held in abeyance as RST were going to build a large fixed net facility. RST's project became unfeasible and so Clive was tasked to cost the local manufacture of a mobile net. He presented his findings to the Committee and compared them to work done in 2018. The Committee agreed that it would be best to purchase a steel galvanised net from ChinaSportsNets. A proposal will be put to RST for a joint venture on this facility. Action: Simon & Ryan

#### 6. Koh Chang Beach Cricket Tournament (21-23 Aug 2020)

PCC will send 3 teams to KC plus supporters -a total of 35 persons. A discussion named the teams as the PCC Thoroughbreds, PCC Stallions and PCC Carthorses. The matches will be played in the PCC diamond jockey style shirts and black shorts.

#### 7. Social events.

Clive suggested that we needed a social Events Secretary. It was agreed and Reds kindly offered his services. Simon suggested that a suitable cohort might be Trevor Moolman, who would be approached for his support by Reds. A meeting will be held at KC to discuss the scope, frequency and type of events to be planned. Action: Reds

#### 8. AOB

Team Kit – Simon stated that some new kit was required and asked if any new styles should be adopted. The answer was NO. New kit will be obtained. Action: Simon

Gavin has kindly sponsored new baseball style caps for PCC. Thanks Gavin.

PCC Batting and Bowling Board – needs to be updated. Action: Simon
